- 4. Allocations are based on the details submitted by the candidates themselves. These may change during verification and validation process conducted by the University from time to time.
- 5. Candidates must check their dashboard, email, and admission website (www.admission.uod.ac.in) for all communications and updates related to admissions. UoD will not be responsible for a candidate's lack of awareness of the admission guidelines, schedule, Eligibility Criteria, and CSAS(PG) rules.
